



COVID-19 STUDENT FACE COVERING EXEMPTION REQUEST

The recent Salt Lake County Health Order, 2022-1 (effective January 8, 2022) states that “all individuals over the age of two years who can medically tolerate wearing a respirator (or until you are able to obtain a respirator, any well-fitting mask or face covering), regardless of COVID-19 vaccination status or past COVID-19 infection, must wear a respirator, masks or face covering” in public.

Vanguard Academy recognizes that some students may have a medical condition, mental health condition, or disability that prevents wearing a face covering. In order to receive an exemption from the State’s face covering requirements, this form must be completed and returned to the Attendance office at Vanguard **prior to your student attending school without a face covering.**

The current Health Order (2022-1) does not give schools the ability to require the signature of a physician for a mask exemption.
